

NOTIFICATION

for foreign citizens studying at the Federal State Educational Institution of Higher Education "Russian State University of Tourism and Service"

On the basis of **paragraph 18 of Article 5 of Federal Law №115-FZ dated 25.07.2002 "ON THE LEGAL STATUS OF FOREIGN CITIZENS IN THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION"**, foreign citizens are required to fulfill the following requirements:

1. Foreign citizens, who arrived in the Russian Federation **in for purposes not related to the exercise of labor activity, for a period exceeding ninety (90) calendar days, are required to undergo a medical examination.**

The procedure for medical examination is established by Order №1079n of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation dated November 19, 2021.

The procedure includes the following medical examinations and examinations by specialist doctors:

- 1) chemical and toxicological examination (for foreign citizens or stateless persons who have reached the age of 13);
- 2) conducting a blood test: determination of IgG class antibodies to *Treponema pallidum* by enzyme immunoassay and determination of antibodies to *Treponema pallidum* in a passive hemagglutination reaction; determination of antibodies to *Treponema pallidum* by a non-treponemic test (RMP);
- 3) total determination of antibodies of classes M, G (IgM and IgG) to the human immunodeficiency virus HIV-1 and HIV-2 (Human immunodeficiency virus HIV1/HIV2) and p24 antigen in human serum or plasma;
- 4) fluorography, or radiography, or computed tomography of the lungs (for foreign citizens or stateless persons over 18 years old);
- 5) immunodiagnostics using a bacterial allergen with 2 tuberculin units of purified tuberculin in standard dilution (for foreign citizens or stateless persons aged 6 to 7 years inclusive);
- 6) immunodiagnostics with the use of tuberculosis recombinant allergen in standard dilution or, at the request of a citizen, in vitro tests based on the assessment of the release of gamma interferon by T-lymphocytes (for foreign citizens or stateless persons aged 8 to 14 years inclusive);
- 7) immunodiagnostics with the use of tuberculosis recombinant allergen in standard dilution or X-ray chest examination or lung fluorography (for foreign citizens or stateless persons aged 15 to 17 years inclusive);
- 8) bacterioscopic and (or) cultural (crops on solid and liquid nutrient media) examination of sputum or other material or molecular biological examination of sputum or other material for DNA of *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* (*Mycobacterium tuberculosis*) by polymerase chain reaction (PCR) (if there are medical indications);
- 9) bacterioscopic examination of the scraping of the nasal mucosa (staining according to Zil-Nilson) (if there are medical indications);
- 10) examination by a phthisiologist (in order to establish the presence (absence) of an infectious disease that pose a danger to others;
- 11) examination by a dermatovenerologist (in order to establish the presence (absence) of an infectious);
- 12) examination by an infectious disease doctor (in order to establish the presence (absence) of infectious diseases);
- 13) examination by a psychiatrist-narcologist, establishing the fact of the use of narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances by a foreign citizen or a stateless person without a doctor's appointment or new potentially dangerous psychoactive substances and their metabolites, based on the results of a chemical-toxicological study (for foreign citizens or stateless persons who have reached the age of 13).

According to the results of the medical examination of a foreign citizen, he is issued a conclusion in the form of Appendix №2 to the order of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation dated November 19, 2021 №1079n and a certificate, which is issued on the basis of the above research results.

Medical examination is carried out at the following addresses:

- **all medical tests**, with the exception of the examination of a narcologist:

- passing an examination by **a narcologist** in medical institutions of your choice:

A) Moscow region, Pushkino, Moskovsky Prospekt, 39B, in a medical institution: Moscow Regional Clinical and Narcological dispensary in the city of Pushkino

B) Moscow region, Shchelkovo, Krasnoznamenskaya str., 8, building 2, in a medical institution: "GBUZ Shchelkovsky Narcological dispensary".

The working hours of medical institutions: from 9.00 am to 13.00 pm, from Monday to Friday (for medical examination, attendance at the medical institution is mandatory by 9.00 am).

The cost of a full medical examination is approximately 8,000 rubles.

To pass a medical examination, you must have:

1. Passport + its translation (preferably notarized);
2. Migration card;
3. Notification of migration registration;
4. Student ID card or certificate of study at the University (in the case of undergraduate studies).

2. After passing the medical examination, foreign citizens with DOCUMENTS confirming the medical examination are required **to apply to the Intermunicipal Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Russia "Pushkinskoe"** at the address: Moscow region, Pushkino, Naberezhnaya str., 2 office №4, working hours: WEDNESDAY - from 10.00 a.m. to 13.00 a.m., FRIDAY - from 10.00 a.m. to 13.00 a.m.

Foreign citizens who have passed the mandatory state fingerprint registration and photographing are issued a document confirming that they have passed the mandatory state fingerprint registration and photographing.

A copy of the received document must be brought within **1 (one) working day** from the date of receipt **to the Visa Registration Department** to confirm compliance with the visa and migration legislation of the Russian Federation.

WE DRAW ATTENTION TO THE CONSEQUENCES OF NOT PASSING A MEDICAL EXAMINATION, FINGERPRINTING, PHOTOGRAPHING:

The period of temporary stay in the Russian Federation of foreign citizens is reduced in case of non-fulfillment by these foreign citizens of their obligations to undergo mandatory state fingerprint registration, photographing and (or) medical examination.
